New Website Launch—October 30, 2018

As a result of a survey that went out to citizens in 2015, city staff and Councilor Gregg have been working diligently on implementing a new website that has the functionality our citizens requested. We will highlight features in the newsletter over the next several months. Please be patient as we transition and let us know if you find things that are not functional.

- **Notification Center.** Notify Me allows you to subscribe to an unlimited number of email lists. Receive email or text message updates regarding the information you have requested.
- **Calendar.** You will see two separate calendars in the new website, a meetings calendar and events calendar. The meetings calendar will have the agendas, minutes and audio visible when you click on a City Council meeting; and the agenda and minutes will be available for Committee and Commissions meetings.
- **Online Forms.** All of the applications and forms are on the new site as existing pdf files. Forms that can be completed and submitted online will be transitioned in as we create them.

Citizen Alert

Rogue Valley Emergency Management has access to ALL landlines in Jackson and Josephine Counties and sends alerts for areas effected with emergencies. If you do not have a landline, you need to register your cell phone number to get alerts for areas you select at registration. To register your cell phone, to go to **RVEM.org**.

Jackson County also has a Citizen Alert system you can sign up for. Landline telephones included in the 911 database are already registered, but by signing up online you can also be notified by Mobile Phone, Work Phone, Email or Text Message. **Sign up online at www.jacksoncounty.org/alert** or if you don't have access to a computer call 541-608-1210 for assistance.

City Council Meeting Agenda Items

- **Accept Bid on Overlay Project—Shafer Lane.** Council accepted the bid on the overlay project for Shafer Lane, which is partially funded through a Small City Allotment Grant.

October 16, 2018

- **Interim Fire Chief Position.** Council approved hiring Wayne Painter as Interim Fire Chief to help with the transition of Fire Chief Devin Hull's retirement on December 31, 2018.
- **Victorian Christmas Event Packet.** Council approved the event packet for Victorian Christmas.
- **OLCC Liquor License Application for Miners' Bazaar, Inc.** Council approved the OLCC License Application.
- **Transient Lodging Tax Grants.** Council approved the Transient Lodging Tax Grants per the recommendation of the Transient Lodging Tax Committee.
- **Jacksonville Waggin Tails, Inc. Dog Park Ground Lease.** Council approved the Ground Lease for the dog park.
- **Rogue Disposal Contract Renew Dry Creek Landfill Inc.** Council approved extending the Dry Creek Landfill contract with Rogue Disposal.
- **Notice of Appeal: Set Public Hearing Date & Time File No. 2018-119 –Certificate of Appropriateness.** The Public Hearing was scheduled for November 7, 2018 @ 4:00 pm.
- **Accept Bid on Overlay Project Applegate Street.** Council accepted the bid on the overlay project for Applegate Street, which is partially funded through a Small City Allotment Grant.

Citizen Advisory Committee Update—Chapter One of the Comprehensive Plan

In September, 2018, the Committee for Citizen Involvement appointed a Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC) in order to review Chapter One of the Jacksonville Comprehensive Plan. The purpose of the CAC is to provide recommendations for text amendments to the existing document in order to ensure a long-term and viable citizen involvement program. The Committee held their first meeting on October 25. During that meeting, they set a Town Hall meeting for November 29, from 4-6 at Old City Hall.
